Adoption of Members' Code of Conduct

Local Government Act 2000

Local Authorities (Model Code of Conduct) (Wales) (Amendment) Order 2016

As members of Llansawel Community council, we must:

1. Carry out our duties and responsibilities with due regard to the principle that there should be equality of opportunity for all people, regardless of their gender, race, disability, sexual orientation, age or religion;
2. Show respect and consideration for others;
3. Report people/members who we reasonably believe involves or is likely to involve criminal behaviour
4. Give reasons for all decisions
5. Observe the law and the authority's rules governing the claiming of expenses and allowances in connection with our duties as a member
6. Avoid accepting gifts, material benefits or services for ourselves or any person which might place us under an improper obligation
7. Consider and disclose whether we have a personal interest in any issues raised

We must not:

1. Use bullying behaviour or harass any person
2. Do anything which compromises our authority
3. Disclose confidential information
4. Prevent any person from gaining access to information to which that person is entitled by law
5. Attempt to use our position to gain advantage over other persons
